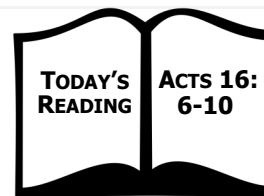


There is no Kidztime or Junior Youth today, however Miranda has activities for children on the tables set up at the back of the church.

And... Carey Nieuwhof: 'Leading Healthy Churches'

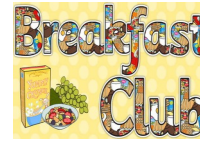
17th May, 9am-5pm at Mornington Presbyterian Church.
