Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty."

John 6: 35 NRSV

John 6 seems to be all about bread - Jesus feeds the crowd with bread and fish, he makes challenging statements - "I am the Bread of Life", "I am the bread that came down from Heaven" and then more challenging still "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life......" Jesus wants the Jews (and us) to learn about the "bread" that really satisfies. He says, 'Eat me, feed on me, take me, the same way you would take a good meal.' 
