Oct 7: Fran is running a DVD and craft activities time.

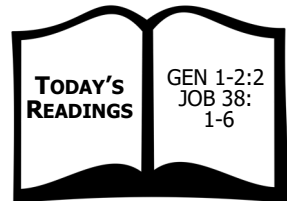
