Comment

James 3 is a very challenging passage emphasising how important it is to be careful what we say. I am an enthusiast and it has been something I've had to work on, not to be too quick to speak. In chapter 1, James writes "Believers must be quick to listen



and slow to speak". He also writes in chapter 2 that what we say must match what we do. "If we say we have faith but do not have works - what good is it?" Word is powerful! We can draw people to the love of God with our speech or we can turn them off. The key to taming our tongues is to bring our lives more completely under the Lordship of Jesus Christ. May Jesus touch our tongues and heal them and fill them with praise.


