Richard made it safely to Pakistan last week, as you probably heard and he and Dennis Flett, his companion from Waitara, preached last Sunday a couple of times. In one location they had to be guarded by men with machine guns! He's been impressed by the depth and fervour of the people's faith and he and Dennis have been called on to pray for many people for healing and other issues.



The Presbyterians have been active in Pakistan since the late 19th century and have established a couple of training institutions, theological and technical. Richard and Dennis visited these to find them thriving but in need of more teachers and support.

Both he and Dennis have had a touch of Delhi-belly which is not pleasant but is not stopping them from participating in all activities.

They were getting a bit of stick about Pakistan beating New Zealand in all 3 T20 cricket matches being played in the UAE, however some face has been saved by the Black Caps beating Pakistan soundly in the first ODI which included a hat-trick by one of our bowlers. Richard will be home this Thursday 15th.

Please keep praying for their safety and also effectiveness in preaching and teaching as well as for the Pakistani Christians who are brave and steadfast in their faith in a country where it is not easy to be a Christian.

who was and is and is to come."

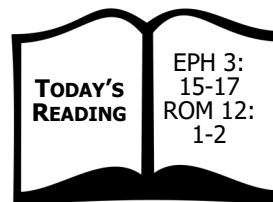
