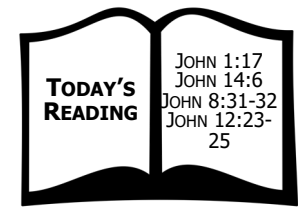
### Notice of Congregational Meeting
