

Finance Report First Quarter 2019

The Council and I would like to give you all an update on where our finances are at, so here goes...Church offerings were 9% ahead of budget for the first quarter of 2019 and total expenses were 8% below, meaning we were able to do some much needed repair work: kitchen taps, toilets leaks, replacing missing light fittings, cleaning years of grime from the couches! etc at the Church (267 Malvern St) and, more importantly,

employ our worship leader for 8 more hours a week. The Council and I are very grateful to those who responded with a lift in giving last year as this has enabled us to stop 'hunkering down' and to look forward and outwards again.

The majority of our congregation give via internet banking or automatic payment. If you would like assistance with setting this up, I am happy to help. Each person/couple/family has a donor number and tax receipts are available today. I organise this each year and am happy to help with any questions about this also.

Phil is the Macauley Professor of International Health in the Department of Preventive and Social Medicine in the Dunedin School of Medicine.

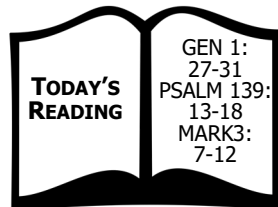

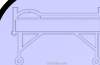


Leith's very own Spotify Worship playlist!
