Sharing Christ

Jesus commanded us to share the news about him. It's probably become one of the least socially acceptable things to do in this society and certainly any mention of punishment or of the afterlife is almost guaranteed to evoke a negative response. And, to a certain extent, this is understandable. We've become experts at bad news and not just bad news but at unwelcome news. We seem, to some, to revel in pronouncements of eternal doom and divine retribution and, no doubt, this is not popular to say the least. But all this is a distraction from the real task before us. We are called to share the Good News of Christ; the fact that Jesus is good for us and for the world and that making Him Lord is the very best thing anyone could do.

However, even this can be viewed as, at the best anachronistic and, at the worst, threatening. The truth is that there will always be those who react badly to Good News. Certainly, we must not turn it into a litany of bad news stories but neither should we water it down to the point that the story is unrecognizable from the Gospel. The Gospel story is simple. We are made for God and to God we will return. What we make of our life here in this life will have eternal consequences. Our best hope for a full and rewarding life is to allow Jesus to lead us. That is what a Christian is – someone who is deliberately and regularly led by God. Now, how can we say this with our lives and with our lips? Richard D
