A Woman's Prerogative...

Is to what? Is, according to the old saying 'to change her mind.' It's not clear where this saying comes from. It certainly reflects Virgil's opinion that "a woman is an ever fickle and changeable thing." What is clear is that the saying reflects a rather unsubtle form of chauvinism by reinforcing the unflattering view that women are, in general, creatures of wavering tastes, opinions and beliefs and that the world of men is, therefore, far more reliable. It's a view which is, these days, completely rejected by the mainstream media but which persists, I believe, in the culture and, indeed, in the Church. This is reflected not just in the very low statistics around women in leadership and the kinds of work women are doing compared to men but also in the self-belief of women. Women can be their own

What is, however, becoming clearer to me each day is that a significant part of the Church's task in reaching the world with the Gospel will be to encourage, equip and support more women to take roles of significance and leadership within the Church. The simple truth that 'our lives preach more eloquently than just about any sermon', means that the life of the Church will have to reflect the equal status the Bible gives to women in the life of faith and of the faith community.

Take Leith for example. We have a great need at present for two more female elders. We only have one female on Session and this represents a significant lack in both our representation and our ability to understand the views of the congregation. Are you willing to step up? Are you willing to give your daughter and son a fuller vision of the kingdom of heaven? Please let me know because if we can't reflect the kingdom balance in the way we live, our preaching will be robbed of much of its power. **R.D.**




