Tom is currently in his final year as a ministry intern at the Knox Centre for Ministry and Leadership and he co-leads Student Soul with Lynne Taylor.


Student Soul is our Student Ministry on campus and this year Tom is working to see people awakened to the call of Christ and equipped for the resulting adventure.
