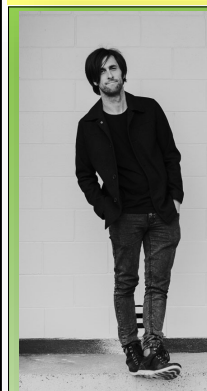

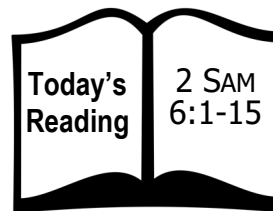
Its great to have Tom Mephram preaching for us today. His topic is fear and anger towards God from 2 Samuel chapter 6.
