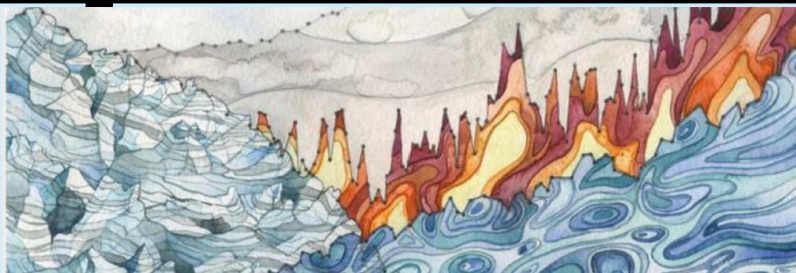


# Art Exhibition, Knox Church

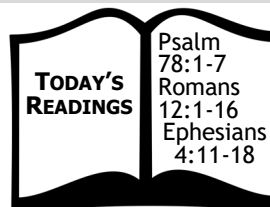
