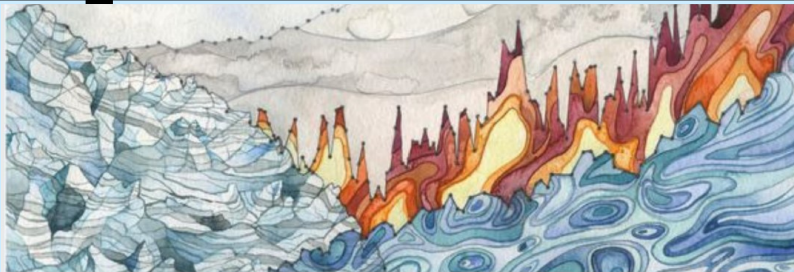


Art Exhibition, Knox Church
