More information about the petition concerning Road safety on George St.

A group of concerned parents/community members are interested in improving aspects of road safety along George Street outside George Street Normal School in light of a recent accident where a young boy attending lessons at Saturday Morning Music Classes (SMMC) was hit by a car running the red light at the pedestrian crossing outside the school. Since the accident, they have been working with the GSNS principal Rod Galloway, who has maintained contact with the DCC and Ministry of Education over the years regarding these road safety concerns and have decided to try more affirmative action coming from beyond just the school, to include concerned rate payers, parents, community members, etc. They have emailed the council and specific councillors to request a meeting to discuss the issues and are starting a petition requesting that the DCC implement some safety improvements as soon as possible, such as raising and painting the pedestrian crossing, placing speed humps on either side of the crossing to help slow down traffic along this stretch of road, creating a reduced speed school zone (to be applicable at all times when the school is in use) and increasing appropriate signage (especially on Warrander St). Alongside the petition they plan to collect anecdotal stories from the communities that regularly use this area/the school property regarding those 'near-misses' and other unsafe incidents that people have observed. All of this is with the intention of presenting the petition and stories to the DCC and pushing for a more immediate response to improving safety features along this portion of George Street.

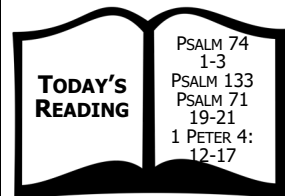
