The fact is, a devil working **behind the scenes** in our life or in the community can be so much more destructive than one we're very much aware of. C. S. Lewis attempted to bring the same thing to light when, in the voice of the senior demon Screwtape, he wrote this to his more junior nephew:

"Indeed the safest road to Hell is the gradual one - the gentle slope, soft underfoot, without sudden turnings, without milestones, without signposts...Your affectionate uncle, Screwtape."

We are never more vulnerable than when we are unaware and again this is reflected in another remarkable saying from Thomas Jefferson which has stood the test of time... "When good people in any country cease their **vigilance** and struggle, then evil men prevail...eternal **Vigilance** is the price of democracy."

This is also a very spiritual truth. The scriptures insist we must take care for we have an 'enemy of our souls' who will stop at nothing to see us rid ourselves of all belief except that which places us alone and in charge in the universe. We are not alone. We have an eternal loving Father who longs to be with us and an implacable enemy who longs to prevent that. *R.D*
