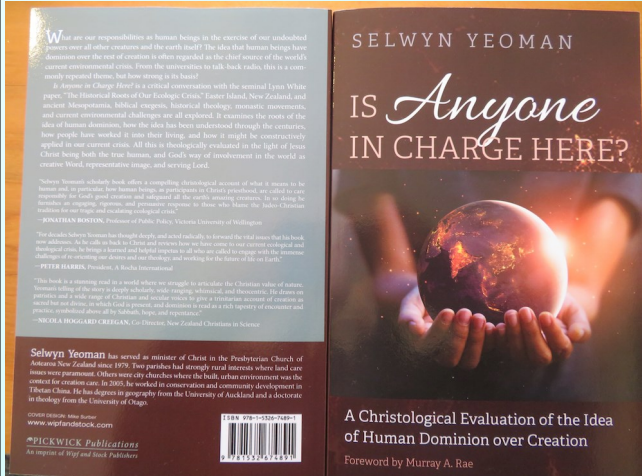


Book Launch

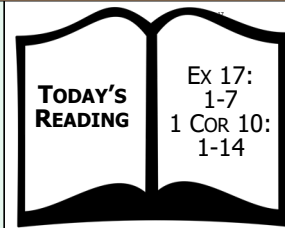
