

### Comment

The dark night of the soul sounds horrendous, I know, but it is actually a Christian concept born out of the experience of a wide variety of medieval Christians but coined first by the Spanish saint, St John of the Cross, around 1577.

The 'dark night' wasn't so much about suffering or loss as it was about deprivation for the sake of truth. There were two major 'deprivations' described by St John. The first, a sensory deprivation and the second, a spiritual one in which love (God) becomes more and more the dominating theme of one's life.

The fascinating thing about this pathway is that it describes to a lesser or greater degree, the pathway to maturity of all love. It does this by highlighting the notion that not until love depends on something other than feelings can it really grow into its fullest expression.

Sense, experience, even simple company can all be a distraction from the one goal of discovering love in and for others but especially within us. Marriage, friendship, at work and in Christian community – all need to grow through the easy stage, to a stage where one's motivation and desire for the relationship is

greater than one's desire for fulfilment through it.

In short love, to be love, exists in its purest form – for itself. When we truly love we love not to attain anything but to give.
