

Everything you need to know about...

Church Donations

- In order to get a receipt of donations made to church at the end of the financial year, you need to have a number, so that your donations can be recorded.

Contact the Church Office to get a number (467 9208, lvally@maxnet.co.nz)

- There are then two ways to give, using this number:

1. Place money/cheque in an envelope, with the number marked on the envelope (or on the cheque) and put it in the offering bag on a Sunday. *If your donation is for a specific purpose or person, please write this on the envelope as well.*
2. Through direct banking to our church bank account (details below). Please remember to use your donations number as a reference when either setting up an automatic payment or making a one-off deposit.

* At the end of the financial year (March), you will be given a receipt for the total amount given during the year. You can use this to claim a tax rebate of 33% of the amount donated (to the limit of your income!)

Giving for those working in missions overseas:

Same as above, but for direct banking, use suffix **02** rather than **00**. It's important that you specify who the money is for so for internet banking, enter this as reference. If depositing at a branch, this is not possible, so you will need to notify church office with details so that amount is put against the right person. Thanks.
