Children & Youth

KIDZTIME (CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMES)

Miranda Fairmaid heads up the Children's Programmes at Leith Valley with assistant Fran Dawson (Sparklers Pre-school Programme) and lots of volunteers -that's you!



Kidztime runs on Sundays during the school term times but provision is made for children in the holiday weekends as well. Miranda prepares the lessons and leads the programmes each week, which are held in the school learning centre, situated behind the classrooms which lead off the deck. The children are all together for the first part then break into age groups for follow up activities. This term they are exploring the Gospels with a focus on Easter. Two other volunteer leaders are needed each week as well as extra helpers so parents are really encouraged to take a turn helping.



Sparklers is the Pre-school programme which is coordinated by Fran Dawson who prepares the lessons.

This caters for all pre-school children and meets in the school staffroom which is found right at the end of the deck.

They begin with a structured time of welcome, story, song and prayer, followed by morning tea and craft or free play. This term they are finding out about "What's in God's Big Book?" Volunteers are needed to lead the sessions as well as act as helpers. Children from the age of two can be left which is why we need at least two helpers each week. Parents are encouraged to take a turn at leading and helping.

Please note, you are welcome to remain in the service with your toddler/baby - there are toys available.



JUNIOR YOUTH

is Leith Valley's Programme for 11-14 year olds or Years 7-10 at school. It runs on Sunday mornings and is led by volunteers, coordinated at present by Rachel Bates.
